The **Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program** brings scholars and experienced professionals to the United States to conduct full-time, non-degree advanced research at the postdoctoral level, to engage in full-time teaching at the college or university level, or to pursue a combination of research and teaching. Grants are awarded from three months up to ten months. Grantees establish professional contacts in their academic field, enhance their scholarly work, gain international experience and personal enrichment, and help promote mutual understanding between the United States and Bosnia and Herzegovina.
