- Participation Fee** **No participation fee is required.**

- Visa Support** Participants who need visa for their travel to Greece, will be supported by the organizers with an invitation letter. Participants have to cover their visa cost and travel insurance.
- Objectives** The Summer School brings together distinguished academics, practitioners, and scientists from around the world to explore inclusive education in the 21st century along with the technology features that enables the "inclusive classes" at schools and universities.
- Program** The programme focuses on the role of inclusive technologies, innovative and evidence-based practices, and transdisciplinary collaboration in creating accessible learning environments. Participants will engage in discussions on how to build inclusive classrooms, strengthen continuous professional development for educators, respond to contemporary social and educational challenges, and contribute to the development of sustainable policies that foster inclusion across education systems and society as a whole.





Under the guidance of prestigious academics and mentors from the fields of inclusive education, special education, pedagogy, technology, educational leadership and policy, the participants will be requested to create influential proposals for inclusive practices.

Through an array of lectures and interactive workshops mainly centered around inclusive education and technology, the participants will gain knowledge of inclusive education practices based on the latest trends worldwide.

Participants will work in smaller groups to design and develop an original work under the guidance of seasoned instructors/mentors.
